The information for the year ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 presented above is extracted from the audited standalone financial statements for the year ended March 31, 2026. These financial statements are prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (IND AS) as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- The Company is principally engaged in a single business segment viz. manufacture and sale of Auto Component – Piston Rings, Differential Gears, Pole Wheel and other transmission Components based on nature of products, risks, returns and the internal business reporting system. The Board of Directors of the Company, which has been identified as being the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM), evaluates the Company's performance, allocate resources based on the analysis of the various performance indicators of the Company as a single unit. Accordingly, there is no other reportable segment in terms of Ind AS 108 'Operating Segments'.
- On November 21, 2025, the government of India notified provisions of the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020 and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020, ('Labour Codes') which consolidate twenty nine existing labour laws into a unified framework governing employee benefits during employment and post-employment. The Labour codes amongst other things introduces changes, including the uniform definition of wages and enhanced benefits relating to leave. The company has assessed the financial implications of these changes which has resulted in increase in gratuity liability arising out of past service cost by Rs.115.11 Lakhs and increase in leave liability by Rs.22.10 Lakhs. Considering the impact arising out of an enactment of the new legislation is an event of non-recurring nature, the Company has presented this incremental amount as "Impact of Labour Codes" under "Exceptional Item" in the Standalone Statement of Profit and Loss for the quarter ended December 31, 2025 and for the year ended March 31, 2026.
